## Key statistics



Children's Hospital Foundation has a long history of supporting sick and injured children. Since our inception in 1985, Children's Hospital Foundation has contributed over **\$264 million** to paediatric healthcare and support across Queensland and northern New South Wales.



On any given day, the team at Queensland Children's Hospital will treat more than **200 children** in its emergency department, see about **1,000 children** at outpatient appointments and care for more than **200 children** as inpatients.



Every year, the Foundation's wrap-around programs at Queensland Children's Hospital support over **130,000 interactions** with young patients and their families.



Children's Hospital Foundation proudly supports and works alongside Children's Health Queensland and the Queensland Children's Hospital - playing an important part in what has become one of the world's best paediatric hospitals.



With over **278,000 outpatient appointments** and **45,000 inpatient admissions** annually, the Queensland Children's Hospital is essential to providing the best possible care to children and their families.
